

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ENTRY

2016-17 (Rev. 4-6-2016)

Physical Exam/Health Assessments: Parents/guardians must submit proof of a health assessment for each child who is presented for admission into kindergarten or a higher grade in the public schools for the first time. The health assessment must have been completed within 12 months prior to the date the child would have first been eligible for initial entry into the public schools.

Immunizations: In compliance with North Carolina law, parents/guardian must present certification of immunizations **on or before the first day of school entry.**

If documentation of required health assessment or immunizations is not presented, parents and/or guardians have 30 calendar days to provide documentation or the student shall be excluded from school until proof is presented.

Immunization Requirements for School Entry 2016-2017

Grade 7-8	5 DTP/DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap 4 Polio 3 Hep B 2 MMR 1 Varicella 1 Tdap 1 Meningococcal (MCV) (as of 7/1/15)
Grades 9-12	5 DTP/DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap 4 Polio 3 Hep B 2 MMR 1 Varicella (if born on or after 4-1-2001) 1 Tdap
