

## Comprehensive Progress Report

**Mission:**

Rocky River High School strives to create a nurturing environment which embraces career readiness, academic proficiency, and global citizenship.

**Vision:**

To create a safe school climate where all students can achieve and teachers are empowered to be creative educators.

**Goals:**

Rocky River High School will provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis. (B2.01)

Rocky River High School will provide duty-free instructional planning time for every teacher under G.S. 115C-105.27 and -301.1, with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week, to the maximum extent that the safety and proper supervision of students may allow during regular student contact hours. (B2.03)

Rocky River High School will provide a positive school climate, under CMS regulation JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. (A4.06)

The percent of high school students who score at the College and Career (CCR) level -- a 4 or 5 -- on the Math 1 EOC (grades 9-12) will increase from <5% (4.5%) in October 2021 to 13.4% in 2022-2023 and 25% in 2023-2024.

The percent of graduates earning a state high school endorsement will increase from 15.1% in 2021-2022 to 45.1% in 2022-2023 and 75% in 2023-2024.

Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) disproportionality for Black students in all grades will decrease from 18.3% in 2021-2022 to 13.3% in 2022-2023 and 8.3% in 2023-2024.

Percent of students reporting a positive self-perception of their engagement in school on the Fall Panorama Screener will increase from 20% in 2021-2022 to 30% in 2022-2023 to 40% in 2023-2024.
